Mayor Huse announced the time and date duly noted, and called the meeting to order.

Councilman Charles Evans gave the invocation.

Mayor Huse called the roll for council men, those present were Jeremy Nelson, Charles Evans, Henry Winsor and Russell Davis.

Fred Curnutt met with the council to present the final plans for the Main Street Improvements; he gave the council new plans and told them about the changes to be made. Motion was made by Jeremy Nelson to approve the plans, it was seconded by Henry Winsor and the motion passed.

Jeremy Nelson made the motion to approve the minutes from the October 20, 2014 meeting; it was seconded by Henry Winsor. Motion passed.

Chief Mc Auley passed out the Police Department report for the month. Chief Mc auley introduced the newest officer Tanner Edwards to the council. Chief McAuley presented Animal Control Officer with a plaque for receiving her certification as Animal Control Officer. He told the council one of the Dodge chargers was in the shop for repairs. Scott discussed with the council a financial plan for the purchase of 4 Ford Explorers and pay \$25,000.00 a year for the next 5 years. Scott reported that the Texas Rangers were coming to help inventory the evidence room and legally dispose of what was necessary . Mayor Huse told the Chief they would discuss the purchase of the vehicles at a later date. Henry Winsor made the motion to approve the police report and Jeremy Nelson seconded it. Motion passed.
