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## RESOLUTION NO. 19-04-01-B

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEAGRAVES, TEXAS ACCEPTING THE SEAGRAVES POLICE DEPARTMENTS RACIAL PROFILING REPORT IN COMPLIANCE OF SB1074, HB 3389 AND TEXAS COMMISSION ON LAW ENFORCEMENT FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2019; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, in 2001, the Texas Legislature adopted laws to address the issue of racial profiling by enacting the Texas Racial Profiling Law. Since 2001, the Seagraves Police Department, in accordance with the law, has collected and reported traffic-related contact data for the purpose of identifying and addressing, if necessary, areas of concern regarding racial profiling practices; and

**WHEREAS**, during the past legislative session, the Racial Profiling Law was modified, and the new requirements are now in place and included in the 2018 City of Seagraves Racial Profile Report; and

**WHEREAS**, this report must be presented to the Seagraves City Council and Texas Commission on Law Enforcement (TCOLE) on an annual basis as evidence of compliance with the Texas Racial Profiling Law.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEAGRAVES, TEXAS:**

**Section 1.** The above and foregoing recitals are incorporated herein and made a part of this Resolution for all purposes.

**Section 2.** The 2018 Seagraves Police Department's Racial Profiling Report, a copy of which is attached to this Resolution as **Exhibit A**, was presented on this date and is hereby accepted by the Seagraves City Council.

**Section 3.** This Resolution shall be effective from and after its passage.

Seagraves Police Department has adopted a detailed written policy on racial profiling. Our policy:

- 1.) clearly defines acts constituting racial profiling;
- 2.) strictly prohibit peace officers employed by the Seagraves Police Department from engaging in racial profiling;
- 3.) implements a process by which an individual may file a complaint with the Seagraves Police Department if the individual believes that a peace officer employed by the Seagraves Police Department has engaged in racial profiling with respect to the individual;
- 4.) provides public education relating to the agency's complaint process;
- 5.) requires appropriate corrective action to be taken against a peace officer employed by the Seagraves Police Department who, after an investigation, is shown to have engaged in racial profiling in violation of the Seagraves Police Department's policy adopted under this article;
- 6.) require collection of information relating to motor vehicle stops in which a citation is issued and to arrests made as a result of those stops, including information relating to:
  - a.) the race or ethnicity of the individual detained;
  - b.) whether a search was conducted and, if so, whether the individual detained consented to the search; and
  - c.) whether the peace officer knew the race or ethnicity of the individual detained before

detaining that individual; and

7.) require the chief administrator of the agency, regardless of whether the administrator is elected, employed, or appointed, to submit an annual report of the information collected under Subdivision(6) to:

a.) the Commission on Law Enforcement; and

b.) the governing body of each county or municipality served by the agency, if the agency is an agency of a county, municipality, or other political subdivision of the state.
